The Department of Education is pleased to announce the availability of TDClient 3.2.2 software for Windows, MVS OS/390, OS/400, HP-UX, AIX, SUN Solaris, and LINUX platforms. Initialization files are available for the SAIG Mainframe/Midrange TDClient installation as well as a new release of the SAIG Host Communication Guide v3.7. The TDClient software and documentation are available on the [Federal Student Aid Download \(FSADownload\)](#) Web site.

TDClient version 3.2.2 includes the following enhancements:

- Internet Protocol version 6 (IPv6) support for FTP and EAFTP protocols
- Bug fixes for compression / decompression

The new TDClient 3.2.2 is compatible for use with both IPv4 and IPv6 connections. If your organization has access to an IPv6 connection and wishes to transmit data across the SAIG using an IPv6 connection, you must upgrade to TDClient 3.2.2. If your organization only has access to an IPv4 connection, you may continue using the previous software version (TDClient 3.2) or upgrade to TDClient 3.2.2. Use of the new software is optional. The previous version of the software is still available for download and organizations may continue to use it if needed.

If you are unsure about the type of connection your institution has access to, we recommend you contact your IT department for further information.

Updates to SAIG Host Communication Guide for Mainframe/Midrange Users v3.7:

- Information has been included about TDClient now supporting IPv6
- Corrected information regarding the Windows installation of the tdclient.ini file
- Added content pertaining to command files and command file usage
